

AUDIOWALKS

TIVOLI

Copenhagen's famous amusement park is like a fairytale in the middle of the city. Open April - September and several days in December.

TOWN HALL

Town Hall, or "Rådhuset", is the hub of Copenhagen and the starting point for the famous walking street "Strøget" - one of the longest walking streets in the world.

GAMMELTORV & NYTORV

Gammeltorv is the oldest square in Copenhagen. Next to it is Nytorv, where public executions took place.

CHRISTIANSBORG

Christiansborg castle lies in the heart of the city and is the home of the Danish Parliament. The castle has a long history and is surrounded by the canal.

THE LIBRARY GARDEN

This green oasis was once an important part of the harbor for the Danish navy. Now it is regularly used as a park by the local residents.

THE STOCK EXCHANGE

Børsen and Holmens Church stand as monuments to Christian IV's passion for building and his influence on the city.

KONGENS NYTORV & NYHAVN

Kongens Nytorv and Nyhavn were developed in the 1670's. Nyhavn is a cozy and historic place to enjoy a cold beer on a long summer's day.

AMALIENBORG CASTLE

Here resides the Danish Royal Family, one of the world's oldest monarchies. The castle lies between two other sights, the Marble Church & the new Opera house.

THE CITADEL

The Citadel is one of Europe's oldest functioning barracks, and is a lovely green and peaceful quarter to visit.

THE LITTLE MERMAID

The legendary sculpture of H.C. Andersen's The Little Mermaid sits here and looks out over the sound.
